Our supper received a total of \$1,035.00 in ticket sales and donations. Our expenses totaled \$456.57 (mainly meal supplies - all advertising was done at no cost). We were awarded a \$250 Thrivent Action Team grant to pay toward the expenses bringing our net proceeds from the supper to \$828.43. All income and expenses of the supper have been processed through our American Lutheran Church Women account with the net proceeds of the supper designated for updating our church kitchen equipment.
